

Sail Away with All at Sea - May News from Cheyenne Blue

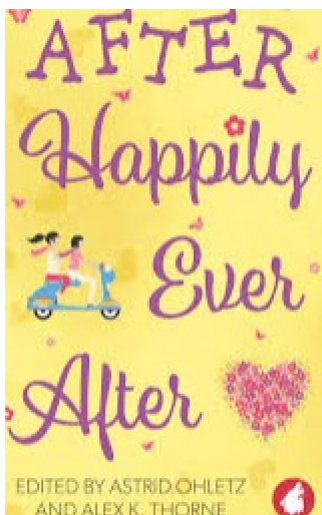
Hello from what is currently a lovely, light-filled but rather cool office in my Work From Home world.



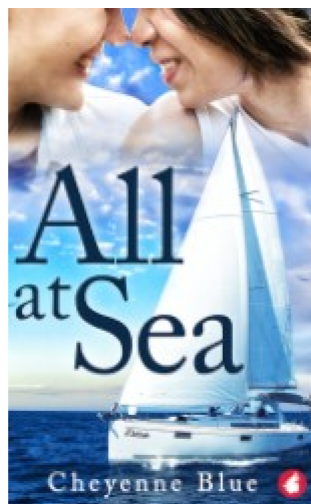
